Secretary Brunner Announces Extended Voting Schedule

COLUMBUS, Ohio – On Tuesday, Secretary of State Jennifer Brunner announced an unprecedented step to help Ohioans cope with the long lines that are expected in this year's presidential election. Secretary Brunner has anticipated historic voter turnout of 80%, or 6,480,000 Ohio voters.

In 2004, 5,625,631 votes were cast. The large turnout caused massive problems statewide at 95% of all precincts. To handle the large turnout expected this year, Secretary Brunner has announced that Ohioans will be casting ballots across three days:
